In The Fall of the Bell System, Peter Temin says that on November 19, 1974, Saxbe announced to colleagues that he would file suit against AT&T that day and that he had "handled" the issue of possible presidential and cabinet objections. In my 1974 calendar, only one entry indicates a meeting with Saxbe, and that entry lists that I met with him and Charlie Joyce on Thursday, March 24 at 10:30. The calendar entry does not identify the subject of the meeting, nor does it list you as attending. I do not recall Charlie being in a meeting with Saxbe, but I seem to recall that the meeting you and I had with him in his private chamber was much later in the year – maybe after Ford became President??
